

**Merrimack Town Council
Nonpublic Minutes
October 13, 2016**

MOTION – Councilor Mahon moved, seconded by Councilor Koenig, to enter into nonpublic session at 6:30 PM for **RSA 91-A: 3, II (e) – Consideration or negotiation of pending claims or litigation**. Motion passed by roll call vote 5-0-0.

Chairman Harrington discussed the Fairpoint settlement offer and explained that there were three parts to the lawsuit. Part one is the Right of Way taxation, part two was Conduit and part three were the poles. Fairpoint filed for tax abatement from 2011 - 2015. This settlement would encumber all of the abatement years.

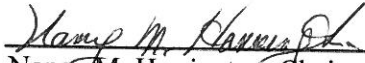
MOTION – Councilor Boyd moved, seconded by Councilor Mahon to enter into a settlement agreement with Fairpoint and pay them no more than \$294,086.

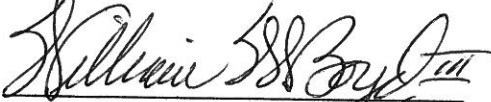
MOTION – Councilor Mahon moved, seconded by Councilor Boyd, to adjourn at 6:58 PM. Motion passed unanimously 6-0-0.



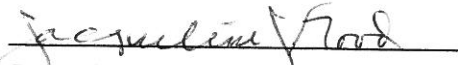

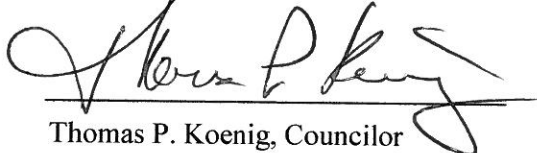
