## **Announcements**

• **2021 Dog Licenses are now available.** Per NH State law, all owners of dogs four months and older are required to license their dog by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Owners must present a valid rabies certificate and a neutering or spaying certificate, if applicable.

Dog owners who fail to register their dog by May 1<sup>st</sup>, will be required to pay late charges, and a \$30.00 Civil Forfeiture fine. A court summons may be issued for each unregistered dog. Licenses are available at the Town Clerk's office during our normal business hours of 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM. License renewals can also be completed by using the on-line payment services at <a href="www.merrimacknh.gov">www.merrimacknh.gov</a>, by mail or by using the drop box. See Dog Licensing in the Town Clerk's section of the website for more information.

• Filing Period for Town offices will be held February 24 to March 5, 2021. Candidates must file with the Town Clerk to have their name placed on the ballot and must be a registered voter and domiciled in Merrimack. (RSA 669:6, 669:19) Candidates for Town Council must also have been domiciled in Merrimack for at least one year. (Town Charter Article 3-4, C)
