- The Department of Public Health with their partner, Convenient MD, and the Town of Merrimack are working together to provide a COVID Vaccination Clinic on Wednesday, 3/16/22 from 3-5pm at the John O'Leary Adult Community Center. All vaccinations and boosters are available for age 5 and up. Appointments are available by calling 603 420-1440 or emailing welfare@merrimacknh.gov. Walk in appointments will also be welcome.
- **2022 Dog Licenses are due by April 30th.** Per NH State law, all owners of dogs four months and older are required to license their dog by May 1st. Owners must present a valid rabies certificate and a neutering or spaying certificate, if applicable. Dog owners who fail to register their dog by May 1st, will be required to pay late charges, and a \$30.00 Civil Forfeiture fine. A court summons may be issued for each unlicensed dog. A court summons may be issued for failure to license. Licenses are available at the Town Clerk's office during our normal business hours of 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM. License renewals can also be completed by using the on-line payment services at www.merrimacknh.gov, by mail or by using the drop box.
