Owners must present a valid rabies certificate and a neutering or spaying certificate, if applicable. Dog owners who fail to register their dog by May 1st, will be required to pay late charges, and a \$30.00 Civil Forfeiture fine. A court summons may be issued for each unlicensed dog. A court summons may be issued for failure to license. Licenses are available at the Town Clerk's office during our normal business hours of 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM. License renewals can also be completed by using the on-line payment services at <u>www.merrimacknh.gov</u>, by mail or by using the drop box.
